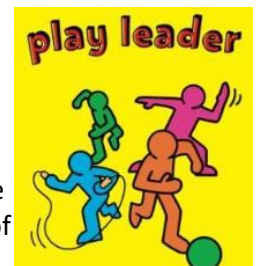
Year 4 Podcasts
