Year 5 – Lifesavers

On Monday afternoon, Year 5 were visited by a team from both Ipswich Hospital and Ipswich Town Football Club, who had come to teach the children more about the importance of being trained to administer CPR (cardio pulmonary resuscitation). It was an active, practical session, where the children worked their way through a scenario and practiced using a dummy. The children are now equipped with knowledge that could help to save a life. Year 3 Scientists

Year 3 are becoming fully immersed in their 'Rocks' topic in science and have been impressing staff with how much they have remembered from their learning in year 2. Last week, the children looked at a special type of rock – the geode! They look like ordinary rocks from the outside, but inside they hold a special surprise. The children learnt that they are usually formed in igneous and sedimentary rocks when minerals collect in gaps within the rock, creating crystals! To bring the topic to life, the children had a go at making their own geodes and have displayed them in their very own class geode gallery! Well done Year 3.



Year 1 Geographers

Year 1 have been learning all about the 7 continents of the world in their Geography lessons. The children have thoroughly enjoyed learning and singing along to 'The Continents Song' - Mrs Collins even said that she is singing it in her sleep!
