
New School Fence

We are very lucky to be receiving a new school boundary fence along the Hadleigh Road perimeter and the perimeter which runs alongside East Bergholt Young Explorers. You may well have seen the Fence Builders on site today, as the work commences. This will raise the school fence height to 1.8 metres high to ensure the safety of the school's pupils. I am sure the children will enjoy watching the fence builders at work as this project continues over the coming weeks.
