

School Council Meeting Minutes – 08.05.24

Thank you to Mrs Sampson for writing to our councilors. The letter was shared with children at the opening of the meeting with individual points discussed.

1) School Houses:

Councilors are very pleased that this idea is being taken forward. It was discussed that this will help bring children from all year groups together and create and supportive culture across the school with children working together in houses.

Councilors are going to take this back to their classes and come up with some ideas for house names. Once they have a list of names, they will then share these at the next school council meeting and as a group, we will make a final decision on the four house names before sharing them with the school.

We agreed this would be something to revisit in the future as we would need to think about how it could be taken care of during holidays and over weekends.

3) Tables:

Blayke had a question about what had happened to the old shared-area tables and wondered if they could be sold to raise money for the school. Mrs Sampson had shared in her letter that the tables had in fact been sold and money raised had been put towards the use of coaches for school trips. Everyone agreed this was a fabulous use of the money.

The school councilors shared that they are very much enjoying their role this year and really feel they are making a difference to life at East Bergholt Primary School.
