Agenda:

1) Tables for shared areas

- The children took the table options to their class council and voted on which they thought would be best for our shared areas around the school.
- The Tuftop adjustable Blue horseshoe table was the clear winner in all of the classes.
- The children shared that they liked that so many children could be seated at once and the teacher would be able to support all of the children and see their work. They also liked that the height is adjustable meaning the same table type can be used across the school for consistency.



2) Wet Play

- Year 6 - Currently mostly draw or play board games – there is often missing pieces so games can't be played properly.
- Year 5 – Currently only colouring, just chat or draw usually.
- Year 4 – In year 4 they put on a film or complete some colouring. There is a wide variety of board games and Issy was happy with the year 4 equipment. She is going to speak to her class to check they agree.
- Year 3 – They have lots of Lego and really enjoy this but there are no instructions for proper sets.
- Year 2 – Would like some new board games, particularly interested in chess.
- Year 1 – Have lots of board games but most of them take a while to set up, meaning less time to play
- Reception – Enjoy playing with the small world toys and Meredith felt like they have plenty of equipment but will be taking this to her class to check everyone agrees.

- School councilors to carry out a vote in class for wet play equipment and feedback at the next meeting
