**What is working well?**

**What needs to improve?**

**Ideas to help improve things**

- To raise the profile of the Play Leaders, it was suggested that the Play Leaders run a skipping competition over a week. The child who manages to do the most skips consistently will win a skipping rope which counts your skips. There will be a third, second and first prize for the pupils in KS1 and the pupils in KS2. Holly and Raife will include this in the PowerPoint they make
