What is working well?

- The children are listening well to the instructions the play leaders are giving
- The games are popular with the children

What needs to improve?

- Some of the older pupils are not following the rules
- The older pupils are being silly with the dress up clothes, and some do not want to pack them away at the end of playtimes
- Younger children like to be special helpers and they get upset if they can't be special helpers everyday
- Some younger pupils get upset when they lose a game

Ideas to help improve things

- If pupils are not following the rules, the play leaders will let Mrs. Sampson know so that she can talk to them. They might need to be given a ban from playing with the equipment for one playtime
- The playleaders suggested making a PowerPoint to show to the older pupils about the rules for the equipment at playtimes (Holly and Raife offered to do this with Mrs. Sampson)
- If the younger children get upset when they are not chosen to be special helpers, the play leaders will ask the teachers on duty for help
- Skylia suggested running another game for pupils who are 'out' e.g. Simon Says
