

Playleader Meeting

Date: 2.2.26

Location: Mrs Sampson's Office

Key points discussed:

- Mrs Sampson explained that there has been some unkind behaviour on the Key Stage 2 playground, such as being disrespectful to adults and upsetting others
- Last year, behaviour improved when playleaders ran activities every day, so the plan is to restart playleading properly.
- Certain playleaders will work on the Key Stage 1 playground so that the younger children can see positive role models

New playleader plan (to try for 2 weeks):

Key Stage 1 playground activities (girls only):

- Monday: Dacia and Heidi – little trikes
- Tuesday: Seren and Bella – dolls and prams
- Wednesday: Dacia and Seren – little trikes
- Thursday: Heidi and Bella – dressing-up box
- Friday: Dacia and Seren – butterfly boards

Key Stage 2 playground activities:

- Monday: Seren and Bella – basketball shootout
- Tuesday: Dom and Heidi – shark attack
- Wednesday: Franklin and Reuben – butterfly boards
- Thursday: Oscar O and Dom – scooters
- Friday: Harry and Reuben – obstacle races

Other important information:

- The plan will be tried for two weeks, then reviewed in another meeting.
- A new lunchtime sports coach will soon be working with Key Stage 2 on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.
- When the weather improves, the field will reopen and more space will be available for activities.
- Children confirmed they still have timers
- Mrs Sampson will check on the progress of an outdoor equipment shed with Mrs Blowers.
- In the summer, there are plans to collect tyres, crates, guttering and bamboo so children can build and create on the field.

Next steps:

- The new playleader timetable will start immediately.
- Playleaders should give feedback to Mrs Sampson about how it is going.
- Another playleader meeting will be held after two weeks to review and improve the plan.
