Focus: Introduction to School Council and Aoife's Bubbles 'Go Gold' Snack

1. Welcome and Role of the School Council

- Welcomed the new School Council representatives.
- Discussed how School Council will meet every two weeks on a Wednesday during assembly time.
- Reminded children that they have been chosen to represent the views and ideas of their classmates.
- Representatives should listen to children in their classes and bring ideas, suggestions or issues to School Council meetings.
- These could include:
 - ideas about learning and school life;
 - suggestions for improving our school;
 - ideas for charity and fundraising events;
 - issues that children in their class would like School Council to discuss.
- School Council will work with Mrs Collins and Mrs Felgate to consider these ideas and help make positive changes across the school.

2. Aoife's Bubbles Charity

- Introduced the School Council's first responsibility: supporting our 'Go Gold' event for Aoife's Bubbles.
- Aoife's family created Aoife's Bubbles in her memory to raise money and support families with children who are very poorly.
- Discussed some of the ways the charity helps families, including running clubs and providing special care packages for children in hospital.

3. 'Go Gold' Snack – Friday 25th September

- On Friday 25th September, children will be able to purchase a special golden snack for £1.
- The snack will be a biscuit with a gold star.
- All money raised will go to Aoife's Bubbles Charity.

4. School Council Actions

School Council representatives agreed to:

- Tell their classes about the 'Go Gold' event and remind them that the golden snack will cost £1.
- Create posters advertising the 'Go Gold' Snack to display around the school.
- Help on the day by collecting/carrying the golden snacks from the kitchen to their classrooms.
